FIRESWISS FOAM fire-resistant glass

Urban living on the edge of town

In Bülach, north of Zurich, a new city district has been created on the site of a former glassworks – the Glasi-Quartier Bülach. The aim was to establish a vibrant neighbourhood with high density, social diversity, and space for commerce, dining, and community areas. To achieve this urban density on just four hectares, Duplex Architekten first defined a tight network of polygonally

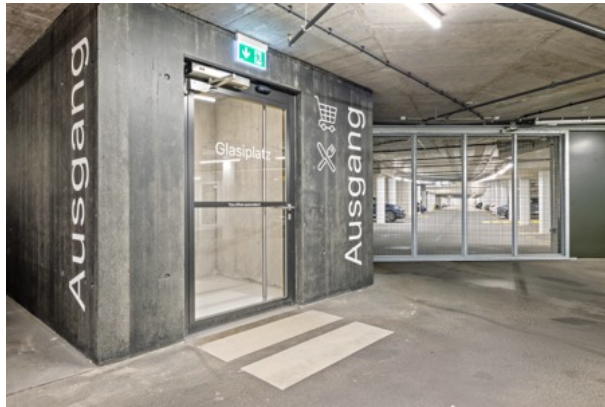
arranged streets, alleys, and squares. The equally polygonal buildings, designed afterwards, are coordinated yet individually distinct.

Due to the high density of the district, the project developer set rigorous fire protection requirements for the buildings. At the same time, the structural measures needed to be aesthetically pleasing and allow transparency in corridors and escape routes. To meet these needs, fire protection doors and windows with FIRESWISS FOAM fire-resistant glass from Glas Trösch were used.

FIRESWISS FOAM not only protects against fire and smoke but also shields non-load-bearing components from dangerous heat radiation. The laminated glass, featuring Thermo-Transformation Layers (TTS) developed by Glas Trösch, absorbs radiant heat and achieves fire resistance class EI. These layers form a solid, tough foam panel that holds the shards of the fire-exposed float glass. This heat shield allows emergency services to safely navigate escape and rescue routes. Stability for the fire protection doors is provided by Forster profile systems. The planning, production, and installation were carried out by Hammer Metall AG.
